

Eaten Alive

"I'm swimming along there in the waters of Florida and then a whole group of fish came swimming along. ... I took my spear gun, I aimed it up at that group of fish and suddenly fish scattered everywhere! All except for one. One poor little fish was flopping around with the spear right through it and I didn't feel like a hunter. I felt terrible. What have I done?

"I pulled the line back, I took the fish, I pulled the spear out and wanting to say I'm sorry, I held him up and let him go and he's flopping kind of sideways and then ... bit by bit, bite by bite, [his fish friends] *ate him!* Right in front of my eyes, he disappeared! ...
