For Marlene Ferreras, assistant professor of practical theology at La Sierra University, the goal of her research trip to Yucatán, Mexico, in Nov. 2016 was straightforward — to collect data utilizing scientific research methods to shed light on the struggles of female Mayan workers at multinational maquila manufacturing plants. But through a threemonth immersion into the daily life of a village family and numerous conversations with the community's *mexicana* assembly line seamstresses, the scope of her analysis deepened to ultimately offer a reshaping of the paradigm of how pastoral care can support marginalized peoples who are suffering. <u>MORE</u>



To inspire the next generation of Adventist teachers, Southern Adventist University piloted the

nation's first Aspiring Teachers Clubs for students at Georgia-Cumberland Academy and Collegedale Academy in 2022. **Youth!** The Valuegenesis (VG) Project is a research effort that has been going strong for more than 30 years, providing a unique window into the lives, beliefs, and experiences of Adventist young people. The NAD Office of Education, the John Hancock Center for Youth and Family Ministry at La Sierra University, and a dedicated team of researchers have conducted three previous studies known as VG1 (1990), VG2 (2000), and VG3 (2010). In October 2021, the project launched its fourth iteration, Valuegenesis 4 (VG4), slightly delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
