The Valuegenesis (VG) Project is a research effort that has been going strong for more than 30 years, providing a unique window into the lives, beliefs, and experiences of Adventist young people. The NAD Office of Education, the John Hancock Center for Youth and Family Ministry at La Sierra University, and a dedicated team of researchers have conducted three previous studies known as VG1 (1990), VG2 (2000), and VG3 (2010). In October 2021, the project launched its fourth iteration, Valuegenesis 4 (VG4), slightly delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
